Coming up in August, Jessica Lang is heading to Chicago to begin working with Joffrey Ballet on her new commission for the company. Her work will premiere in the company's Eclectica program in April 2010 with works by Gerald Arpino and James Kudelka. While in the windy city, Lang's piece, *To Familiar Spaces In Dream*, will be performed by Richmond Ballet at the Chicago Dancing Festival's *New Voices* program, a performance dedicated to showcasing a new generation of American Choreographers. Following the festival, Lang will travel to Richmond, VA with the company where she will create her fifth world premiere for Richmond Ballet.

Also happening around the globe in August, American Ballet Theatre principals, Irina Dvorovento and Maxim Beloserkovsky, will be touring Lang's *Splendid Isolation III* to the Tuscan Sun Festival in Cortona, Italy. Her solo work *Wally*, danced by Courtney Lopes, will also be featured at the performance of the fifth anniversary celebration of the ABT Summer Intensive Program in Bermuda.
